Visit the beautiful and undisturbed Homeland of Bawaka, which is located on the beachfront in Port Bradshaw south of Nhulunbuy. Bawaka is a beautiful tropical paradise with visitor access by 4WD, helicopter or boat. The scenic trip takes around 90 minutes (45 mins on dirt road and 45 mins on sand) by 4WD from Nhulunbuy.

The Homeland features unspoilt beaches, spectacular cliff-top ocean views, vast areas of bushland and an amazing array of marine life.

Bawaka Homeland offers:

- Day visits
- Camping
- Secluded bay site with shade shelters
- BBQ/tea/coffee facilities
- Tables and chairs
- Opportunities to participate in Yolŋu daily life and learn about bush medicine and the history of the land.



Activities include:

- Cultural awareness sessions
- Campfire singing (traditional and modern)
- Dancing
- Handline and traditional fishing (a wide range of reef fish, clams, crayfish and oysters)
- Art and craft (painting, basket weaving, carving)
- Bushwalking
- Archaeology (Macassans)
